CD Transfer Status

- Transfer \$4,000 to Fish Fry (FF) Reserve.
- Consider a higher yielding account for the FF fund, i.e., SSB checking, high-yield or other account that will generate more interest.
- There are 4 FF CDs maturing: ~ March 7, March 11, May and June of 2015. Consider moving these from CD's to a higher interest bearing account.
 - o The minutes of February 9, 2014 records a vote to move the FF funds to a more liquid account, providing Ed Christner felt this was a wise move.
- Consider using some of the FF money next year, i.e., \$10,000, to help offset what the church has to front for the FF fish and supplies.

Membership Blitz

- Fr. Peter is aware and willing to help us again with an announcement at St. James and Our Lady of Assumption.
- Will need posters and handouts. We may have what materials are needed for this blitz.

- Consider setting up a recruiting table during the St. James 4th Degree meeting on February 24, 2015.
- Need to have someone with literature and forms at OLA the weekend of the Blitz.

- FS Bill Snowdin announced the 1st and 2nd place winners of the Poster Contest as: Ava Meyer and Grace McDowell.
- The St. Mary of the Woods blood drive collected 29 units of blood. The next blood drive will be March 2^{nd} .
- The Habit for Humanity fund raising dinner sold 260 meals and raised \$2,300 from dinners and a \$250 donation from the 12985 KC council. This group will be starting their 11th house this year locally.
- JR Savoie reported that it will cost \$18,511.50 to procure fish for this year's fish fry. Plus about \$4,000 in food and supplies from Gordon Foods. Currently the church fronts this money for the KC. Our goal is to be able to front this expense ourselves.
- Steve Nagengast noted that he has been working with Bill Bartholomew and Jim Bolger on a Fish Fry Fund Raiser that will be held during the Lenten Fish Fry's. The cost is \$100 / ticket. Only 400 tickets will be sold. The proceeds to fund one or more charities that will be announced. Winners to be announced on March 28th.
